Pool:

- 25 yards, 6 lanes, Omega Touchpads & Starting Platforms, 6 Lane TV readout for Athlete 1 Line scoreboard for spectators and anti-turbulent lane lines. The water depth of the competition) measured for a distance of 3'3 ½" (1.0 meter) to 16'5" (5.0 meters) from the start wall is 9' to 12'6", and the water depth at the turn wall when measured for a distance of 3'3 ½" to 16'5" (5.0 meters) is 4' to 4'2". (USA-S Rule 202.3.4.D).
- The host will ensure the required course dimensions.
- MAXIMUM Capacity: 287 in pool area, including the pool, deck and stands.

**FACILITY:** 

- Medical supervision available: Brownell Talbot coaches are certified Red Cross lifeguards. An AED, emergency
  telephone, and first aid kit are available in the pool area. Rescue equipment includes backboards with neck
  immobilizers, rescue tubes, and a shepherd's crook .Brownell Talbot does not offer athletic trainers or
  rehabilitation facilities. Ice is available for injuries on campus and may be obtained by asking a Brownell
  Talbot coach.
- No glass containers will be allowed on the pool deck or in the stands. Any consumption of food must be done
  outside of the pool area.
- Sanitizing stations for athletes, volunteers, and any spectators will be at the entrance of the meet as well as at the pool deck entrance.
- Brownell Talbot School reserve the right to remove from the premises any individual who might jeopardize safety and facility privileges.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Two gender specific facilities are available at this facility. Gender specific locker rooms will be available for athletes only. Athletes are expected to arrive and depart in their suits. DISABILITY
SWIMMERS:

Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the Deck Referee of any disability prior to competition.

RULES:

Current USA Swimming Rules and Midwestern Rules will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

**CREDENTIALS:** 

- Presentation of coach's membership credentials will be required at coach sign-in. Credentials shall be available at all times. The USA Swimming App is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.
- In accordance with MWS Policy, only those coaches who hold current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- All swimmers, coaches and clubs must be currently registered with USA Swimming and Midwestern Swimming. Athletes must be PREMIUM athlete members.
- NO on deck registration permitted. NO late entries permitted.
- Athletes who appear as unregistered on the first pre-meet recon must register with Midwestern immediately. A second pre-meet recon will be run 4 days prior to the start of the meet and any unregistered athlete that appears on that list must register with Midwestern Swimming and will be charged an additional \$30.00 above the current MW registration fee and must provide proof of registration before being allowed to swim in the meet. Meet management must delete unregistered athletes from the meet file prior to meet commencement.
- The age of the swimmer on July 18, 2024, determines his/her age for the entire meet.
- No Time Standards
- Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by
  a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from
  within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure
  compliance with this requirement.

#### **ENTRY LIMITS:**

- Individual Events: 5 Individual Events & 2 Relay
- Relays A, B, C, D
- No time trials.
- The 4-hour rule will be applied. The host will accept no further entries for a session with 12 & Under swimmers where a 4-hour projected time limit is reached. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit events, heats, teams, and swimmers to conform to the 4-hour time limit (205.3.1F). Teams will be notified of any and all necessary adjustments.

# GENERAL MEET CONDUCT:

- All events will be timed finals and pre-seeded.
- Report any scratches as soon as possible.
- All starts will take place in the deep end of the swimming pool. All events other than 25 yard swims will finish into the deep end wall. Deep end wall will have electronic touch pads at the end of every lane. 25-yard events will finish to the shallow end wall. Two timers will be at the end of those lanes recording finish times.
- All events swum Fastest to Slowest.
- Fly over starts will NOT be used. Swimmers will enter and exit the pool before the next swimmer is allowed to enter the block area to get on the blocks.
- Each swimmer shall report promptly to his/her assigned lane prior to the start of each race in which he/she is entered and stand on the X on the ground when waiting for their heat to be called.
- No Time Trials. No Exhibition swimming.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

- Locker rooms will be available for use and will be monitored.
- MWS Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, or club for the failure to follow the safety rules.
- Swimmers will be assigned time and lanes for warm-ups.
- Swimmers are to sit and slide entering water.
- During sprint starts, swimmers must swim one direction only from deep to shallow.

TEAM

Deck changes are prohibited.

**SUPERVISION:** 

Each Team will have a specified team area with chairs on the pool deck.

**MEET RESULTS:** 

Available via Meet Mobile, and paper copies will be posted on the pool deck.
